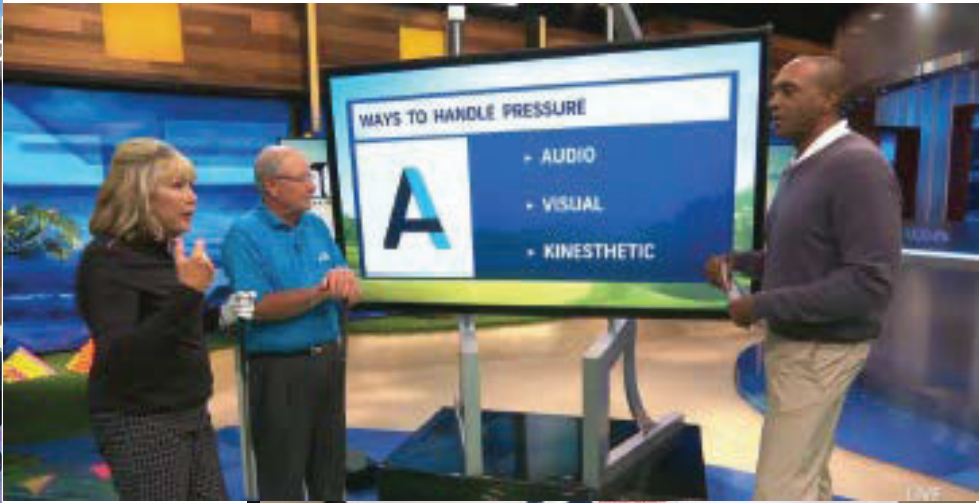

Dear Junior Golf Parents,

We are committed to teach those who want to excel at the game of golf and are offering the opportunity for each student to reach their personal potential. With that goal in mind, we are creating some new programming to ensure we are able to help each student reach their goals.

Learning to play golf at the highest level requires each student to learn many skills. The progression or pathway includes:

- FUNdamentals- learn the fundamentals of the game while having FUN. Games will be used to ensure both learning and enjoyment.
- Learn to Play- Skill Acquisition- Developing Technique
- Train to Play- Practice your skill. Target training. Accountability. Scoring.
- Learn to Compete- Plan- Prepare- Produce Learning to assess your options, making decisions, commitment, course management, and produce shots.
- Train to Compete- Mindset, Emotions, Pressure, Course Management
- Train to Excel- Fine tuning all the above





We understand each child is unique. Their desires and your goals will be different. With that in mind, we have created a few choices for you.

1. You can continue to come to group clinics and/or private lessons as you know them. Cost per child will be \$20 plus range balls.

The development of junior golfers is heavily reliant on appropriate instruction, equipment, and proper group assignment. It is essential for a junior golfer to be properly classified.

This will ensure their placement in the proper group based on skill level. This allows our coaches to guide players through the phases of development using an objective criteria and developmental mind-set. The Miller Golf Junior Program has been broken up into multiple levels. Each level will require testing on skill level, etiquette, equipment, and knowledge.
